Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$820,847.25 in funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management. The Hazard Mitigation Grant agreement is authorized between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Division of Emergency Management. The Public Buildings Division of the Department of Public Works will provide oversight. The 2020-2024 CIP is amended to provide funding for the project.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the purchase and installation of permanent generator at the Police Memorial Building. The purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe weather or other hazards.

Policy Impact Area: Police Memorial Building generator

Fiscal Impact: \$820,847.25 as initiated by B.T. 20-077 in FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant funds
