Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the

8 (c) Explanation of Appropriation 9 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency 10 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation 11 Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of 12 Emergency Management for the purchase and installation of 13 a permanent generator at the Department of Health 14 Building.

15 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 16 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation 17 of a permanent generator at the Department of Health Building. The 18 purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce 19 and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe 20 weather or other hazards.

21 Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby 22 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 23 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on 24 behalf of the City, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Contract 25 Number H0337 between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida 26 Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed 27 ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services.

28 Section 4. Oversight. The Public Buildings Division 29 of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project 30 described herein.

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Section 5.

CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being

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the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City 1 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to 2 provide funding for the project entitled "Department of Health 3 Generator Replacement." The project is more fully described in the 4 Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** 5 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the 6 7 deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the 8 9 community because such deferral will result in the City's loss of 10 needed grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of 11 two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of 12 the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall 13 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other 14 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by 15 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect. 16

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become
effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
without the Mayor's signature.
