6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$224,959.50 GRANT  
7 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY,  
8 FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT  
9 PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA DIVISION  
10 OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR THE PURCHASE AND  
11 INSTALLATION OF A PERMANENT GENERATOR AT THE  
12 TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT FACILITY, AS INITIATED BY  
13 B.T. 20-094; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
14 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
15 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
16 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE HAZARD MITIGATION  
17 GRANT PROGRAM CONTRACT NUMBER H0429 BETWEEN  
18 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA  
19 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; PROVIDING  
20 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION  
21 OF THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;  
22 AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL  
23 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE  
24 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT  
25 ENTITLED "TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT FACILITY  
26 GENERATOR REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
27 DATE.

29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
31 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the

1 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
2 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

9 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

10 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency  
11 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation  
12 Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of  
13 Emergency Management, for the purchase and installation  
14 of a permanent generator at the Traffic Management  
15 Facility.

16 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
17 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation  
18 of a permanent generator at the Traffic Management Facility. The  
19 purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce  
20 and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe  
21 weather or other hazards.

22 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
23 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation  
24 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on  
25 behalf of the City, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Contract  
26 Number H0429 between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida  
27 Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed  
28 **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

29 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Public Buildings Division  
30 of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project  
31 described herein.

1           **Section 5.           CIP Amendment.**     Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
2 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City  
3 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
4 provide funding for the project entitled "Traffic Signals Generator  
5 Replacement." The project is more fully described in the Project  
6 Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated  
7 herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of  
8 this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP  
9 review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community  
10 because such deferral will result in the City's loss of needed  
11 grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,  
12 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
13 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
14 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
15 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other  
16 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by  
17 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

18           **Section 6.           Effective Date.**     This ordinance shall become  
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
20 without the Mayor's signature.
