19 Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, 20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the 21 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to 22 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

30 \$5,000,000.00 is a portion of the Federal CARES Act grant 31 funding received by the City from the Federal government pursuant 1 to the CARES Act. These funds are being appropriated from the 2 COVID-19 Economic Impact - City stimulus response funds and shall 3 be placed in a Council Contingency fund for future consideration of 4 use by the City Council in a manner authorized by the CARES Act.

5 Section 2. Repealing a portion of Section 3 of Ordinance 6 The portion of Section 3 (Purpose) of Ordinance 2020-235-E. 7 2020-235-E that provided \$5,000,000 of CARES Act funds to fund the six-month Building Inspections Fee moratorium is hereby repealed. 8 Instead, the \$5,000,000 of CARES Act funds shall be placed in a 9 designated contingency for future appropriation by the City Council 10 11 pursuant to the CARES Act and the fee moratoriums that impact the 12 Building Inspection fund will be covered by available fund balance 13 within the fund.

Amending Section 6 of Ordinance 2020-235-E. 14 Section 3. 15 Section 6 (Waiving Section 106.304(b) and (c) (Mayor's transfer 16 power), Subpart A. (General Provisions), Part 3 (Appropriations), (Budget and Accounting Code), Ordinance Code) 17 Chapter 106 of Ordinance 2020-235-E that waived the provisions of Chapter 106 18 (Budget and accounting Code), Part 3 (Appropriations), Subpart A 19 20 (General Provisions), Section 106.304(b) and (c) (Mayor's transfer power) related to the \$25,000,000 designated to fund the costs of 21 the fee moratoriums and other economic stimulus measures ("COVID-19 22 23 Response Funds") is hereby amended to reduce the Mayor's transfer 24 authority for such purposes to \$20,000,000.

25 Section 4. Rule 4.901 Requesting one cycle Emergency 26 Passage. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is 27 requested. The nature of the emergency is that the negative health 28 and economic impacts of COVID-19 are ongoing and immediate economic 29 assistance is needed to maintain the viability of businesses and 30 ease the financial needs of the citizens of Duval County impacted 31 by COVID-19.
