A RESOLUTION CONCERNING LITIGATION STYLED CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND JEA V. MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC AUTHORITY OF GEORGIA, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF GEORGIA CASE NO. 1:19-CV-3234-MHC; APPROVING AND ENCOURAGING THE MAYOR TO SETTLE THE LITIGATION; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES UPON ADOPTION TO FORWARD THE RESOLUTION TO THE MAYOR'S OFFICE; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville and JEA brought a lawsuit against Municipal Electric Authority of Georgia, which is currently pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, Case No. 1:19-cv-3234-MHC ("the Plant Vogtle litigation"); and

22 WHEREAS, while the City is a party to the Plant Vogtle 23 litigation, the relief requested by the City was nonmonetary 24 relief; and

WHEREAS, Section 112.303, Ordinance Code, confers authority to settle all nonmonetary claims brought by the City to the Mayor and his department heads; and

WHEREAS, all of the parties to the Plant Vogtle litigation have reached a tentative settlement agreement to resolve all claims brought by the parties; and WHEREAS, the City Council supports JEA's approval of the settlement during its July 28, 2020 Board Meeting; and

3 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to resolve its 4 claim against Municipal Electric Authority of Georgia without 5 resort to further litigation, costs and expense; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 Section 1. The Council does hereby approve and encourage 8 the Mayor's office to settle the Plant Vogtle litigation styled 9 <u>City of Jacksonville and JEA v. Municipal Electric Authority of</u> 10 Georgia.

Section 2. Direction to Legislative Services. The Council further directs the Chief of Legislative Services to forward this resolution upon adoption to the Mayor's Office.

14 Section 3. Requesting Emergency passage upon introduction 15 pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage of this 16 legislation upon introduction is requested. The nature of the 17 emergency is that there are upcoming litigation matters requiring 18 immediate attention, and it is in the best interest of the City to 19 have finality in this matter as soon as possible.

20 Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become 21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 22 without the Mayor's signature.
