Type of Action: Amending Section 106.109 of the Ordinance Code; defining pre-consolidation City boundary

Bill Summary: The bill amends Section 106.109 (Capital Improvement Funding), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code) of the Ordinance Code to establish a target of at least 33% of the CIP budget to be allocated for capital improvements within the pre-consolidation City boundary as prescribed by this legislation. Attached to this bill as "Exhibit 1" is a map outlining the pre-consolidation City boundary. The Map source is from the City of Jacksonville Public Works Department, 1962.

Background Information: The language for this provision has been added to Sec. 106.109 as subsection (b) and reads as follows:

(b) The City Council establishes a target of at least 33% of the capital improvement Plan Budget as defined in 122.602(c), to be allocated for capital improvements in the Pre-consolidation City boundary. The Capital Improvement Plan Budget target shall be reported each year in a separate section in the Mayor's budget proposal to the City Council.

The previous paragraph in this section has been labeled subsection (a) and is otherwise unchanged.

Policy Impact Area: CIP budget allocations; pre-consolidated City borders and boundaries

Fiscal Impact: The bill will dedicate at least 33% of the CIP budget to be allocated for capital improvements within the pre-consolidation City boundary.
