Bill Summary: The bill appropriates funds in the amount of \$400,000.00 to provide funding for the City of Jacksonville to be used as the city's contribution to the Jacksonville Chamber of Commerce for FY20-21.

Background Information: The purpose of the appropriation is to provide funding from the City to the Jacksonville Chamber of Commerce to be used exclusively for the following: advertising, target industry marketing to brand our region's key sub-clusters and outreach to site selectors and corporate decision makers. The annual Chamber membership fee is ordinarily budgeted in the City's annual budget ordinance in a dues and memberships line item. However, because of the conflict of interest posed by his employment with the Chamber of Commerce, a council member would have had to abstain from voting on the budget on this item which was funded therein. It was decided to put the annual membership appropriation into a separate ordinance from which the council member can abstain from voting while voting on the rest of the budget separately.
