7 EMPOWERMENT FUND ("CFE") TO SUPPORT THE KIDS  
8 HOPE ALLIANCE ("KHA") IN DEVELOPING DURING THE  
9 PERIOD MAY 1, 2020 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2021 A  
10 PLAN FOR INTEGRATING COMPREHENSIVE FINANCIAL  
11 EDUCATION AND BANKING ACCESS INTO THE CITY OF  
12 JACKSONVILLE'S 2021 SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT  
13 PROGRAM, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-101;  
14 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the

28 The funding above is a grant received from CFE to support  
29 KHA in developing during the period May 1, 2020 through  
30 April 30, 2021 a plan for integrating comprehensive  
31 financial education and banking access into the City of

1 Jacksonville's 2021 Summer Youth Employment Program.

2 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
3 this ordinance is to support KHA in developing during the period  
4 May 1, 2020 through April 30, 2021 a plan for integrating  
5 comprehensive financial education and banking access into the City  
6 of Jacksonville's 2021 Summer Youth Employment Program. At least  
7 1,000 youth are expected to be served in the City of Jacksonville's  
8 2021 Summer Youth Employment Program. These youth will benefit from  
9 financial education and banking access programming. The grant term  
10 will run from May 1, 2020, through April 30, 2021.

11 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
13 without the Mayor's signature.
