RESOLUTION 2020-499

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING JEA LINEWORKERS ON FLORIDA LINEWORKERS APPRECIATION DAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida House Resolution 9089: Lineworker Appreciation Day, was introduced by Representative Seth McKeel and adopted on March 3rd, 2012, designating August 26th as Lineworker Appreciation Day in the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Florida Lineworker Appreciation Day was created to show gratitude to the men and women who risk their lives daily to ensure reliable delivery of electricity throughout Florida. It was designated by the Florida House of Representatives in 2012 in memory of Marc Moore, a lineworker for Lakeland Electric, who was tragically killed while serving his community in 2002; and

WHEREAS, national studies consistently rank power line installers and repairers among the most dangerous jobs in the country, and for good reason. Laboring high in the air wearing heavy safety equipment and working directly with high voltages creates the perfect storm for a dangerous and unforgiving profession. Despite the long hours and dangerous conditions, lineworkers are up to the task; and

WHEREAS, to perform their jobs successfully, lineworkers depend on their years of training, experience and each other to get the job done safely. Equally important is their reliance on a strong support system at home, a lineworker's family understands

and supports their loved one's commitment to the greater community during severe storms and power outages. This means that in times of prolonged outages, the family and their lineworker may have minimal communication and not see each other for several days. Without strong family support and understanding, this challenging job would

be all the more difficult; and
