AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO PROVIDE DIRECT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$631,018 TO THE JACKSONVILLE ALLIANCE FOR KIPP SCHOOLS, INC. TO ALLOW ENHANCED SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO AT-HOPE CHILDREN AND YOUTH ΙN JACKSONVILLE; APPROPRIATING \$444,698.00 FROM UNSPENT PART-TIME DOLLARS WITHIN THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE PRETEENS AND TEEN ESSENTIAL SERVICES CATEGORY INTO THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE OUT-OF-SCHOOL TIME ESSENTIAL SERVICES CATEGORY, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 20-090; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING CHILDREN'S SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY JACKSONVILLE ALLIANCE FOR KIPP SCHOOLS, INC. SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CHILDREN'S SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE JACKSONVILLE ALLIANCE FOR KIPP SCHOOLS, WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF

77.111(a) (PROVIDER CONTRACTS), CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAMMING TO BE PROVIDED BY THE JACKSONVILLE ALLIANCE FOR KIPP SCHOOLS, INC. FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of appropriation

The funding above is an appropriation of \$444,698.00 from unspent part-time dollars within the Kids Hope Alliance Preteens and Teen Essential Services Category into the Kids Hope Alliance Out-of-School Time Essential Services Category.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize Kids Hope Alliance to provide direct funding in the amount of \$631,018.00 to the Jacksonville Alliance for KIPP Schools, Inc. to allow enhanced Services to be provided to at-hope children and youth in Jacksonville and to allow Kids Hope Alliance to transfer unspent part-time dollars within the Kids Hope Alliance

Section

Preteens and Teen Essential Services Category into the Kids Hope Alliance Out-of-School Time Essential Services Category as shown on the Second Revised 2019-511-E Schedule M, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

Section 3. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The Kids Hope Alliance is hereby authorized to procure children's services from the Jacksonville Alliance for KIPP Schools, Inc. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such services are exempted from competitive solicitation because the children's services to be provided are being appropriated and approved in this authorizing legislation.

Section 4. Approval and authorization to execute. The Mayor, or his designee, the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief Executive Officer of the Kids Hope Alliance ("CEO") are hereby authorized to execute a contract with the Jacksonville Alliance for KIPP Schools, Inc.

Section 5. Waiver of the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts). The City hereby waives the provisions in Chapter 77 (Kids Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts) with respect to the contracts approved and authorized under Section 3 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for children's services to be competitively procured by Kids Hope Alliance via an evaluated bid process. The waiver is needed in order to allow the Kids Hope Alliance to continue to support these children's services that were not eligible to be included in Kids Hope Alliance's most recent Request for Proposal for out-of-school time programming due to the unique nature of the model used by the Jacksonville Alliance for KIPP Schools, Inc.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become

effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
