7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$1,370,895.00  
8 GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT  
9 AGENCY, FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION  
10 GRANT PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA  
11 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, AS INITIATED  
12 BY B.T. 20-076; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE  
13 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION  
14 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON  
15 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE HAZARD MITIGATION  
16 GRANT PROGRAM CONTRACT NUMBER H0336 BETWEEN  
17 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA  
18 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; PROVIDING  
19 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION  
20 OF THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;  
21 AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL  
22 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE  
23 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT  
24 ENTITLED "PRE TRIAL DETENTION FACILITY  
25 GENERATOR REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE  
26 DATE.

28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
30 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the

1 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
2 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

9 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

10 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency  
11 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation  
12 Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of  
13 Emergency Management.

14 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
15 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation  
16 of a permanent generator at the Pre Trial Detention Center. The  
17 purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce  
18 and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe  
19 weather or other hazards.

20 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
21 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation  
22 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on  
23 behalf of the City, Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Contract Number  
24 H0336 between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Division of  
25 Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed **ON FILE** with  
26 the Office of Legislative Services.

27 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Public Buildings Division  
28 of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project  
29 described herein.

30 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
31 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City

1 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
2 provide funding for the project entitled "Pre Trial Detention  
3 Facility Generator Replacement." The project is more fully  
4 described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as  
5 **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP,  
6 August 3, 2020 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference.  
7 The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP  
8 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to  
9 the best interests of the community because such deferral will  
10 result in the City's loss of needed grant dollars. Pursuant to  
11 Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance  
12 requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members  
13 present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in  
14 this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to  
15 Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital  
16 Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue  
17 in full force and effect.

18 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
20 without the Mayor's signature.
