(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation of a permanent generator at the Pre Trial Detention Center. The purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe weather or other hazards.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Contract Number H0336 between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed ON FILE with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 4. Oversight. The Public Buildings Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 5. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City

and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Pre Trial Detention Facility Generator Replacement." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP, August 3, 2020 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in the City's loss of needed grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
