8 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$152,125.00 FROM  
9 DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND LOAN PROCEEDS TO PROVIDE  
10 FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, CONTINGENCY, AND  
11 PERSONNEL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REPAIR AND  
12 UPGRADE OF BRIDGE 724043 ON NORMAN THAGARD  
13 BOULEVARD, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-088;  
14 AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL  
15 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE  
16 2019-505-E TO REDUCE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT  
17 ENTITLED "COUNTYWIDE INTERSECTION IMP, BRGE-  
18 BRIDGES" AND PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT  
19 ENTITLED "NORMAN THAGARD BOULEVARD BRIDGE  
20 UPGRADES"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
26 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

3 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

4 The funding above is from Debt Management Fund Loan  
5 Proceeds for the construction, contingency, and personnel  
6 costs associated with the repair and upgrade of Bridge  
7 724043 on Norman Thagard Boulevard.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
9 Section 1 is to provide funding to upgrade to current Florida  
10 Department of Transportation (FDOT) standards the guardrails on  
11 Bridge 724043 on Norman Thagard Boulevard and thus provide the  
12 driving public with traffic railing that will better prevent errant  
13 vehicles from breaking through the railing and crashing into the  
14 creek. The asphalt at the approaches to the bridge is damaged and  
15 needs to be repaired. The repair items associated with this project  
16 constitute safety upgrades and major maintenance to the bridge  
17 guardrail and pedestrian barriers.

18 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being  
19 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City  
20 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to  
21 reduce funding for the project entitled "Countywide Intersection  
22 IMP, Brge-Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled  
23 "Norman Thagard Boulevard Bridge Upgrades." The projects are more  
24 fully described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto  
25 as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP,  
26 August 3, 2020 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference.  
27 The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP  
28 until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to  
29 the best interests of the community because such deferral will  
30 result in unnecessary delay in repairing critical transportation  
31 infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,

1 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-  
2 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the  
3 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall  
4 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other  
5 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by  
6 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

7 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
9 without the Mayor's signature.
