15 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND FDOT;

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21 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a grant from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for participation in project management of design for Intelligent Transportation System on Bay Street from I-95 to Festival Park Drive.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund a project to provide greater stormwater resiliency, cameras for transportation operations and public safety, and fiber optic communications for future expansion to be identified in the BayJax (Bay Street Innovation Corridor) Project.

**Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Local Agency Program Agreement between the City and FDOT, a copy of which has been placed **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

**Section 4. Oversight.** The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project described herein.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
