AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$193,248.00, WITH NO LOCAL MATCH, FROM FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT FOR THE NATION CRIME STATISTICS EXCHANGE PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 30, 2020, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30,2021, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-107; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY THE CERTIFICATE OF SUBAWARD AND THE ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL FUNDING ASSISTANCE BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JSO; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

- (c) Explanation of Appropriation
  - The funding above is from the Florida Department of Law

Enforcement for the Nation Crime Statistics Exchange Program for the period April 30, 2020, through September 30,2021. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to assist the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO) with meeting the January 2021 deadline to submit crime data to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and, subsequently, to the FBI. The project includes analysis, the creation of the required data elements, and test submissions to FDLE. This one-time transition does not warrant additional full-time positions; thus, JSO is proposing the use of a procurement contract for temporary staff augmentation. Under the procurement contract, two individuals will perform work over a nine month period to: 1) conduct an analysis; 2) extract/build the necessary data elements into the Records Management System (RMS); and, 3) complete test submissions.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City the Certificate of Subaward and the Acceptance of Federal Funding Assistance between the City and FDLE, in substantially the same forms attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Oversight. JSO shall oversee the Program.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
