(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement for the Project Safe Neighborhoods Program (the "Project") for the period May 1, 2020, through April 30, 2021. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the Project. The Project will install fixed-place license plate readers (LPRs) within the Targeted Enforcement Area ("TEA") outlined in the U. S. Attorney's Office Strategic Action Plan for Jacksonville. More specifically, the LPRs will be deployed within the ShotSpotter area and Zone 4. The LPRs will feed data into the Real Time Crime Center so that the information can be provided to first responders who are responding to calls for service and to detectives who are conducting follow-up investigations.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City the Project Safe Neighborhoods - Middle District of Florida (PSNM) Program Special Conditions and Acceptance of Federal Funding Assistance between the City and FDLE, in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Oversight. JSO shall oversee the Project.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
