8 LAW ENFORCEMENT FOR THE PROJECT SAFE  
9 NEIGHBORHOODS PROGRAM (THE "PROJECT") FOR THE  
10 PERIOD MAY 1, 2020, THROUGH APRIL 30, 2021, AS  
11 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-108; APPROVING AND  
12 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND  
13 THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND  
14 DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY THE PROJECT SAFE  
15 NEIGHBORHOODS - MIDDLE DISTRICT OF FLORIDA  
16 (PSNM) PROGRAM SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND  
17 ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL FUNDING ASSISTANCE  
18 BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW  
19 ENFORCEMENT AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE;  
20 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY JSO; PROVIDING AN  
21 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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23 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,  
25 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the  
26 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to  
27 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

3 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

4 The funding above is from the Florida Department of Law  
5 Enforcement for the Project Safe Neighborhoods Program  
6 (the "Project") for the period May 1, 2020, through April  
7 30, 2021. No local match is required.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
9 Section 1 is to fund the Project. The Project will install fixed-  
10 place license plate readers (LPRs) within the Targeted Enforcement  
11 Area ("TEA") outlined in the U. S. Attorney's Office Strategic  
12 Action Plan for Jacksonville. More specifically, the LPRs will be  
13 deployed within the ShotSpotter area and Zone 4. The LPRs will feed  
14 data into the Real Time Crime Center so that the information can be  
15 provided to first responders who are responding to calls for  
16 service and to detectives who are conducting follow-up  
17 investigations.

18 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby  
19 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation  
20 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of  
21 the City the Project Safe Neighborhoods - Middle District of  
22 Florida (PSNM) Program Special Conditions and Acceptance of Federal  
23 Funding Assistance between the City and FDLE, in substantially the  
24 same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by  
25 this reference.

26 **Section 4. Oversight.** JSO shall oversee the Project.

27 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
29 without the Mayor's signature.
