**ORDINANCE 2020-529** 

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 120 (GENERAL EMPLOYEES AND CORRECTION OFFICER PENSION PLANS ALL EMPLOYEES DEFINED CONTRIBUTION AND RETIREMENT PLANS), PART II (THE GENERAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT PLAN), SECTION 120.206 SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFIT; COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO PROVIDE A SIX MONTH WINDOW FOR EARLY RETIREMENT AS FOLLOWS: (1) RETIREMENT AT THE AGE OF 60 WITH 5 YEARS CREDITED SERVICE; (2) RETIREMENT AT THE AGE OF 55 WITH 10 YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE; AND (3) EARLY RETIREMENT WITH 20 YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE, WITH A REDUCED BENEFIT; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; REQUIREMENT ACTUARIAL REPORT; REQUIRING COLLECTIVE BARGAINING WHERE APPLICABLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amending Section 120.206, Ordinance Section 120.206 (Time Service Retirement Benefit; cost-of-living adjustments), Part II (The General Employees Retirement Plan), Chapter 120 (General Employees and Correction Officer Pension Plans and All Employees Defined Contribution Retirement Plans), Ordinance Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## PART II. THE GENERAL EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT PLAN

Section 120.206. Time service retirement benefit; cost-of-living adjustments.

\* \* \*

- (j) Notwithstanding any other provision in this Section to the contrary, prior to March 31, 2022, a member may retire on the next pay period following: the date upon which the member attains age 55 with 10 years of credited service or the date upon which the member attains age 60 with five years of credited service. Such benefits will be based on final monthly compensation and credited service as of the date of termination.
- (k) Notwithstanding any other provision in this Section to the contrary, prior to March 31, 2022, early retirement shall be available to a member the first full pay period following the completion of 20 or more years of service, but less than 30 years of service, regardless of age with a benefit of two percent per year of credited service or the attainment of age 50 and a completion of 20 years of credited service with the benefit of 2.5 percent per year of credited service reduced by 0.5 percent for each month the benefit commencement precedes age 55.

Section 2. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "tables of contents" consistent wit the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 3. Requirement of Actuarial Report to be filed with

the State Division of Retirement before final reading and adoption of legislation. Pursuant to Section 112.63(3), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 120 (General Employees and Corrections Officers Pension Plans and all Employees Defined Contribution Retirement Plans), Part I (Provisions Applicable to System as a Whole), Section 120.102 (Administration of the Retirement System), subsection (v), Ordinance Code, the City must have prepared and file an actuarial report with the State Division of Retirement before final reading and adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Collective Bargaining. If or as required, the City will collectively bargain with unions representing covered bargaining unit employees of City.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
