10 Section 3. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 11 Section 1 is to provide funding for AAA Public Engagement Workshops 12 for Continued Resiliency Planning. Funds will be used to engage the 13 public through several workshops at which sea level rise and 14 flooding scenarios will be presented along with proposed policies 15 or recommendations to address these issues.
