The funds above are Investment Pool Earnings, which will be used to fund the demolition, removal, remediation, and replacement of both sections of the elevator/pit system in the Moran Theatre. Accounting will move actuals from 32109-191009-361101-000000-00001451-00000-0000000.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funds for the demolition, removal, remediation, and replacement of both sections of the elevator/pit system in the Moran Theatre.

Section 3. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide funding for the project entitled "Performing Arts Center -Performing Arts Center - Building Systems." The project is more fully described in the Project Information Sheet, attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Revised CIP, August 17, 2020 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary further delay in this needed improvement. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of twothirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.
