Bill Summary: This amends Section 118.101 (Purpose), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), *Ordinance Code*, to prohibit City grants from being awarded to any entity to fund any program supporting or assisting sexual predators or sexual offenders.

Background Information: The purpose of the legislation is to restrict the use of any City grant funds that are targeted for use in programs that provide assistance to sexual predators or sexual offenders. Such funds could only be awarded to a recipient for use in such programs if the recipient has entered into an agreement with the Sheriff whereby the Sheriff will perform whatever inspections, monitoring or other legal requirements that are applicable to sexual predators and sexual offenders.
