RESOLUTION 2020-562

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THEMONTH OF SEPTEMBER AS SUICIDE PREVENTION MONTH ΙN JACKSONVILLE; REQUESTING EMERGENCY UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN **EFFECTIVE** DATE.

WHEREAS, suicide is a large and growing public health problem, with more than one million suicide attempts and more than 47,000 deaths by suicide in the United States, and 3427 in Florida, and 177 deaths by suicide in Duval County last year; and

WHEREAS, suicide deaths can occur across the life span, but suicide is the second leading cause of death for people 10 to 34 years of age. Nationally, there were more than twice as many deaths by suicide than by homicide last year. The risk for suicide is much higher for certain population groups, including military veterans, LGBTQ youth, and among people who have experienced child abuse, bullying, or sexual violence; and

WHEREAS, suicide deaths affect the health of the whole community, but especially family and friends who may experience shock, depression and guilt. Public health research indicates that knowing someone who dies from suicide can increase one's own risk, but also that suicide deaths can be prevented, as 9 out of 10 suicide attempt survivors do not go on to die by suicide; and

WHEREAS, at the community level, suicide prevention public

health strategies include: strengthening economic supports for financial stability, increasing mental health care access, decreasing public stigma, promoting relationship connections, teaching emotional coping skills, and implementing trained crisis intervention protocols. Suicide deaths may also be prevented among friends and within households by creating protective environments, lessening harms to prevent future risks, and reducing access to lethal means, such as firearms which were involved in half of all suicides last year; and

WHEREAS, Duval County is a strong advocate for "The Fire Watch" program, which focuses on combating the epidemic of veteran suicide by providing one-on-one counseling, local telephone helplines, web resources, and a smart-phone application to unite our War Fighters and allies to swiftly activate local assets, stand watch, and build a life-saving network for Northeast Florida veterans; and

WHEREAS, World Suicide Prevention Day is September 10th, and September 6-12, 2020 is National Suicide Prevention Week. Suicide prevention strategies are needed in Jacksonville to raise public awareness, and to promote resilience, with particular attention paid to individuals and communities known to be at heightened risk; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby declares the month of September to be Suicide Prevention Month in Jacksonville and advocates for all residents to work together to prevent suicide deaths. With this declaration, City Council strives to reduce the stigma surrounding suicide, educate the community as to the warning signs and intervention methods, and to encourage access to mental health support for all who need it.

Section 2. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction

pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon 1 2 introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the 3 emergency is that World Suicide Prevention Day is September 10th, and September 6-12, 2020 is National Suicide Prevention Week and 4 City Council desires to show its support to make strides locally to 5 prevent suicide attempts and deaths within our community, with 6 7 particular attention paid to individuals and communities known to 8 be at heightened risk.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
