9 Α RESOLUTION CONCERNING EARLY RETIREMENT BENEFITS PERTAINING TO THE GENERAL EMPLOYEES 10 PENSION PLAN, CHAPTER 120, PART II, ORDINANCE 11 CODE; APPROVING AND ENCOURAGING THE MAYOR TO 12 EXPLORE ADDITIONAL EARLY RETIREMENT BENEFITS 13 14 FOR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL EMPLOYEES 15 RETIREMENT PLAN; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF 16 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES UPON ADOPTION TO FORWARD 17 THE RESOLUTION ΤO THE MAYOR'S OFFICE; 18 REQUESTING AN ACTUARIAL REPORT; REQUESTING ONE 19 CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN 20 EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 120, Part II, Section 120.206, Ordinance Code, sets forth and provides certain benefits under the City of Jacksonville's General Employees Pension Plan (the "Plan");

WHEREAS, City Council supports exploring the enhancement of early retirement benefits for certain members of the Plan to protect the health and welfare of such members in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, and to potentially provide cost savings to the City; now therefore

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BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The Council does hereby approve and encourage
 the Mayor's office to explore additional options for early
 retirement for members of the Plan.

4 Section 2. Direction to Legislative Services. The Council
5 further directs the Chief of Legislative Services to forward this
6 resolution upon adoption to the Mayor's Office.

7 Section 3. Requesting an Actuarial Report. The Council 8 requests the Mayor's office to obtain an actuarial report in 9 connection with any proposed additional early retirement benefits 10 under consideration by Council.

11 Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. One Cycle emergency passage of this 12 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the 13 impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic are ongoing and early retirement 14 for certain members of GEPP can provide for the safety and welfare 15 of such employees and reduce costs to the City. 16

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
