7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE KIDS HOPE
8 ALLIANCE TO PROVIDE DIRECT FUNDING IN THE
9 AMOUNT OF \$200,640.00 FOR COMMUNITIES IN
10 SCHOOLS OF JACKSONVILLE, INC. ("CIS") TO
11 PROVIDE CHILDREN'S SERVICES IN AN AFTERSCHOOL
12 AND SUMMER PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING THE KIDS HOPE
13 ALLIANCE TO CONTRACT DIRECTLY WITH CIS TO
14 PROVIDE AFTERSCHOOL AND SUMMER PROGRAMMING AT
15 CARTER G. WOODSON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FOR THE
16 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR AND THE IMMEDIATELY
17 FOLLOWING SUMMER; AMENDING 2019-511-E SECOND
18 REVISED SCHEDULE M TO INCLUDE COMMUNITY IN
19 SCHOOLS OF JACKSONVILLE, INC.; INVOKING THE
20 EXCEPTION TO SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS),
21 PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126
22 (PROCUREMENT CODE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, REGARDING
23 THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAMMING TO BE
24 PROVIDED BY CIS AS SPECIFIED IN THIS
25 ORDINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
26 DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR
27 THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE
28 ALLIANCE TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A CHILDREN'S
29 SERVICES CONTRACT WITH CIS; WAIVING THE
30 REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 77 (KIDS HOPE

1 ALLIANCE), SECTION 77.111(a) (PROVIDER
2 CONTRACTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO EXEMPT THE
3 CHILDREN'S SERVICES PROGRAMMING TO BE PROVIDED
4 BY CIS FROM COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING
5 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
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7 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

8 **Section 1. Background.** Communities in Schools of
9 Jacksonville, Inc. ("CIS") has operated an afterschool and summer
10 program at Carter G. Woodson Elementary School for the past three
11 years within the Out-of-School ("OST") Essential Services Category.
12 This school was not listed as a possible site in the new Request
13 For Proposal issued by the Kids Hope Alliance in March 2020 (the
14 "RFP"), as, at the time of release, Duval County Public Schools
15 ("DCPS") intended to close the school for the 2020-2021 school
16 year. Since that time, DCPS has decided to keep the school open and
17 would like students to continue to have access to these services.

18 **Section 2. Amending 2019-511-E Second Revised Schedule M.**
19 2019-511-E Second Revised Schedule M is hereby amended to include
20 Community in Schools of Jacksonville, Inc., a copy of the Third
21 Revised Schedule M is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

22 **Section 3. Invoking the exception to Section**
23 **126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126**
24 **(Procurement Code), Ordinance Code.** The Kids Hope Alliance is
25 hereby authorized to directly procure children's services from CIS
26 for afterschool and summer programming at Carter G. Woodson
27 Elementary School for the 2020-2021 school year and the immediately
28 following summer in the amount of \$200,640.00. Pursuant to Section
29 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126
30 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such services are exempted from
31 competitive solicitation because the children's services to be

1 provided by CIS are being approved in this authorizing legislation.

2 **Section 4. Approval and authorization to execute.** The
3 Mayor, or his designee, the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief
4 Executive Officer of the Kids Hope Alliance ("CEO") are hereby
5 authorized to execute and deliver a contract with CIS for the
6 children's services described in this legislation.

7 **Section 5. Waiving the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids**
8 **Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance**
9 **Code.** The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids
10 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), *Ordinance*
11 *Code*, with respect to the children's services contract approved and
12 authorized under Section 3 of this ordinance. Section 77.111(a)
13 requires contracts for children's services to be competitively
14 procured by the Kids Hope Alliance via an evaluated bid process.
15 This waiver is needed in order to allow the Kids Hope Alliance to
16 continue to support these CIS children's services that were not
17 eligible to be included in the Kids Hope Alliance's most recent RFP
18 for out-of-school time programming due to the DCPS' change in plans
19 for Carter G. Woodson Elementary School.

20 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
