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ORDINANCE 2020-58-W

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE JACKSONVILLE AVIATION AUTHORITY TO WITHDRAW FROM THE RISK MANAGEMENT INSURANCE PROGRAM OPERATED BY THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 128.106, ORDINANCE CODE; PROVIDING FOR A RETURN OF JAA FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR A PROSPECTIVE EFFECTIVE WITHDRAWAL DATE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Aviation Authority ("JAA") is an independent authority of the City of Jacksonville, organized and existing under Chapter 2001-319 Laws of Florida, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the JAA participates in the City of Jacksonville's Self-Insurance Program, specifically in the automobile liability, general liability and worker's compensation self-insurance program as established by the City of Jacksonville Risk Management Code ("Code"), Section 128.101, et. seq; and

WHEREAS, Section 128.106 (Withdrawal of Participating Independent Agencies from the Self-Insurance Program), Ordinance Code, provides the process by which a participating agency can withdraw from the Self-Insurance Program; and

WHEREAS, the JAA Board of Directors, at its November 25, 2019 board meeting, approved Board Resolution 2019-02 authorizing JAA's formal request to the City Council to withdraw from the Self-Insurance Fund in accordance with the procedures set forth in Section 128.106, Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, a Participating Independent Agency, once admitted to participate in the Self-Insurance Program, may not withdraw from the Self-Insurance Program without the consent of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's approval of such withdrawal shall designate whether the withdrawing Participating Independent Agency shall assume administration of their existing claims by agreeing to assume control of, responsibility for, and payment of all existing claims the City was administering in the Self-Insurance Program as of the withdrawal effective date of the Participating Independent Agency's withdrawal or pay the City for continued administration of their existing claims by establishing a funding agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Council's election of the withdrawing Participating Independent Agency to assume administration of their existing claims or pay for City continued administration, all funds being held by the City for the payment and administration of the outstanding claims shall be returned to the withdrawing Participant; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Receipt of JAA request to withdraw from participation in the self-insurance plan and assume administration of JAA claims. The City of Jacksonville City Council is in receipt of the JAA Resolution 2019-02, a copy of which is incorporated herein and attached hereto as Exhibit 1. At the JAA November 25, 2019 Board meeting, the JAA Board of Directors authorized the withdrawal of JAA from the Risk Management Self-Insurance program operated by the City of Jacksonville and to assume administration of JAA claims, in accordance with Section 128.106, Ordinance Code.

Section 2. Approval and authorization for JAA to withdraw from participation in self-insurance plan and assume administration of JAA claims. The City Council does hereby approve and authorize

the JAA to withdraw from the Risk Management Self-Insurance Program operated by the City of Jacksonville and assume administration of JAA claims, in accordance with Section 128.106, Ordinance Code. The City Council's approval of such withdrawal recognizes the JAA request to assume control of, responsibility for, and payment of all existing claims the City was administering in the Insurance Program as of the withdrawal effective date.

Section 3. Return of JAA funds. The City Council does hereby approve and authorize the return of JAA funds in the Risk Management Self-Insurance Fund upon final calculation as of the Withdrawal Effective Date in accordance with the procedures set forth in Section 128.106, Ordinance Code.

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Section 4. Prospective effective withdrawal date. Τn order to allow JAA to comply with the administration assumption of the JAA claims with an accurate accounting of funds to be returned as of the withdrawal effective date, the Participating Independent Agency's withdrawal shall be on the last day of the month immediately following 30 days from the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
