ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY ΑN ACRES, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 AT 1718 EDGEWOOD AVENUE NORTH, BETWEEN LUCILLE ROAD AND 5^{TH} STREET WEST (R.E. NO. 048942-0102), AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY JOHN F. GARCIA AND CARMEN E. GARCIA, FROM COMMERCIAL OFFICE (CO) DISTRICT TO PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, TO PERMIT COMMERCIAL, OFFICE, AND EDUCATION USES, AS DESCRIBED IN THE STRIVING EXCELLENCE ACADEMY PUD; PROVIDING FOR DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, John F. Garcia and Carmen E. Garcia, the owners of approximately 1.07± acres, located in Council District 10 at 1718 Edgewood Avenue North, between Lucille Road and 5th Street West (R.E. No. 048942-0102), as more particularly described in Exhibit 1, dated June 17, 2020, and graphically depicted in Exhibit 2, both of which are attached hereto (Subject Property), have applied for a rezoning and reclassification of that property from Commercial Office (CO) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District, as described in Section 1 below; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the application and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice
and public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and
WHEREAS, the Council finds that such rezoning is: (1)
consistent with the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; (2) furthers the
goals, objectives and policies of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and
(3) is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use

WHEREAS, the Council finds the proposed rezoning does not adversely affect the orderly development of the City as embodied in the Zoning Code; will not adversely affect the health and safety of residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties in the general neighborhood; and will accomplish the objectives and meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit Development) of the Zoning Code; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Commercial Office (CO) District to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District. This new PUD district shall generally permit commercial, office, and education uses, and is described, shown and subject to the following documents, attached hereto:
