BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for costs to install a new all-weather coating and other associated improvements on an outdoor sports court at the Potter's House Christian Academy located at 5731 & 5732 Normandy Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32210, in Council District 9, as more fully described in Exhibit 2 attached hereto.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in Section 1 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal year 2020-2021.

Joint Use Agreement approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and The Potter's House Christian Fellowship, Inc., in substantially the form as attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). Agreement provides for the City and citizens of Jacksonville to use the Sports Court and to provide certain programming on the Sports Court located at 5731 & 5732 Normandy Blvd. The Agreement may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to the Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the

amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of the Potter's House Christian Fellowship, Inc. as stated in the Agreement, and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the Agreement.

Section 5. Oversight. The Mayor is requested to appoint the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department to oversee the project in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other appropriate laws.

Section 6. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that \$25,000 of the funding will lapse on September 30, 2020. These funds are being appropriated to cover 50% of the project described in Section 2 above.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
