The funding above is a Fiscal Year 2020 Emergency Performance Management Grant Program COVID-19 Supplemental (EMPG-S) in the amount of \$45,130.14 from Homeland the U. s. Department of Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) through the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) for the purchase of a heavy duty tow vehicle for the Infectious Disease Response Unit.

14 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the EMPG-S is to assist local governments with their public health and emergency 15 management activities supporting the prevention of, preparation 16 17 for, and response to the ongoing Coronavirus Disease 2019 public health emergency. The appropriation in Section 1 will be used to 18 19 purchase one heavy duty tow vehicle for the Infectious Disease 20 Response Team that will support the Emergency Preparedness 21 Division's logistics and supply chain management for COVID-19 22 public health response operations, such as alternate care sites, 23 points of dispensing and distribution, healthcare facility PPE, and 24 COVID-19 screening and testing sites. The grant period expires June 25 30, 2021.

Section 3. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between the Division of Emergency Management and the City of Jacksonville, in substantially the same form placed **On File** with the Office of
