7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$682,795.88
8 (\$620,723.53 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND
9 SECURITY/FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY
10 (FEMA) AND A 10 PERCENT CITY MATCH OF
11 \$62,072.35 FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING
12 RESERVES FOR FEDERAL PROGRAMS) TO PROVIDE
13 FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF PERSONAL
14 PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE), INCLUDING
15 OPERATING AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES, IN RESPONSE TO
16 THE CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19), AS
17 INITIATED BY B.T. 20-106; AUTHORIZING THE
18 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
19 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON
20 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE FEDERALLY-FUNDED
21 SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN FDEM AND
22 CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR CITY
23 OVERSIGHT BY THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS
24 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

26 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
28 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
29 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
30 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

7 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

8 The funding above is a Fiscal Year 2020 Assistance
9 to Firefighters Grant COVID-19 Supplemental (AFG-S) from
10 the U. S. Department of Homeland Security/Federal
11 Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) (\$620,723.53) and a 10
12 percent match from the General Fund Operating Reserves
13 for Federal Programs (\$62,072.35) to provide funds for
14 the purchase of personal protective equipment (PPE) and
15 related supplies, including reimbursements, to prevent,
16 prepare for, and respond to coronavirus (COVID-19).

17 **Section 2. Purpose.** The AFG-S is a supplemental funding
18 opportunity under the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program
19 (AFG). AFG is one of three grant programs that constitute the
20 Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management
21 Agency's (FEMA) focus on enhancing the safety of the public and
22 firefighters with respect to fire and fire-related hazards. The
23 AFG-S Program accomplishes this by providing financial assistance
24 directly to eligible fire departments for critical personal
25 protective equipment and supplies needed to respond to the COVID-19
26 public health emergency. The grant funding in Section 1 will assist
27 the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department with reimbursement for
28 PPE purchased for COVID-19 response from January 1, 2020, through
29 March 30, 2020 (\$197,895.88), and also provide funding for future
30 expenditures for PPE related to COVID-19 response (\$484,900.00).
31 The grant period expires July 2, 2021.

1 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
2 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary
3 are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of
4 the City, the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement between
5 the Florida Division of Emergency Management and City of
6 Jacksonville, in substantially the same form placed **On File** with
7 the Office of Legislative Services.

8 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Emergency Preparedness Division
9 will provide oversight.

10 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
12 without the Mayor's signature.
