8 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$50,952.25 (\$25,000  
9 FROM SPECIAL COUNCIL OPERATING CONTINGENCY,  
10 \$12,443.55 FROM COUNCIL DISTRICT 9  
11 DISCRETIONARY FUNDS FROM THE BETTER  
12 JACKSONVILLE PROGRAM, \$10,000 FROM COUNCIL  
13 DISTRICT 7 DISCRETIONARY FUNDS FROM THE BETTER  
14 JACKSONVILLE PROGRAM, AND \$3,508.70 FROM  
15 COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 DISCRETIONARY FUNDS FROM  
16 THE BETTER JACKSONVILLE PROGRAM) FOR  
17 IMPROVEMENTS TO AN OUTDOOR SPORTS COURT,  
18 LOCATED AT 5731 & 5732 NORMANDY BOULEVARD,  
19 JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32210, IN COUNCIL  
20 DISTRICT 9; PROVIDING FOR A CARRYOVER OF FUNDS  
21 INTO THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR; APPROVING, AND  
22 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND  
23 CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER,  
24 A JOINT USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF  
25 JACKSONVILLE AND THE POTTER'S HOUSE CHRISTIAN  
26 FELLOWSHIP, INC.; PROVIDING FOR THE PARKS,  
27 RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT  
28 TO OVERSEE THE PROJECT; REQUESTING EMERGENCY  
29 PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN  
30 EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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1 Council District 8 Discretionary funds from the Better  
2 Jacksonville Program) for costs to install a new all-  
3 weather coating and other associated improvements on an  
4 outdoor sports court at the Potter's House Christian  
5 Academy, in Council District 8.

6 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
7 Section 1 is to provide funding for costs to install a new all-  
8 weather coating and other associated improvements on an outdoor  
9 sports court at the Potter's House Christian Academy located at  
10 5731 & 5732 Normandy Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32210, in  
11 Council District 9, as more fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached  
12 hereto.

13 **Section 3. Carryover.** The funds appropriated in Section 1  
14 of this ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover into fiscal  
15 year 2020-2021.

16 **Section 4. Joint Use Agreement approved and execution**  
17 **authorized.** There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his  
18 designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to  
19 execute and deliver, the Funding Agreement between the City of  
20 Jacksonville and The Potter's House Christian Fellowship, Inc., in  
21 substantially the form as attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and  
22 incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"). The  
23 Agreement provides for the City and citizens of Jacksonville to use  
24 the Sports Court and to provide certain programming on the Sports  
25 Court located at 5731 & 5732 Normandy Blvd. The Agreement may  
26 include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable,  
27 necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as  
28 may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such  
29 inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the  
30 Agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no  
31 modification to the Agreement may increase the financial

1 obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the  
2 amount stated in the Agreement or decrease the duties and  
3 obligations of the Potter's House Christian Fellowship, Inc. as  
4 stated in the Agreement, and any such modification shall be  
5 technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and  
6 approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this  
7 Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes  
8 having no financial impact to the City and any other non-  
9 substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties  
10 and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the  
11 Agreement.

12       **Section 5. Oversight.** The Mayor is requested to appoint  
13 the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department to oversee  
14 the project in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all  
15 other appropriate laws.

16       **Section 6. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction**  
17 **pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** Emergency passage upon  
18 introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the  
19 emergency is that \$25,000 of the funding will lapse on September  
20 30, 2020. These funds are being appropriated to cover 50% of the  
21 project described in Section 2 above.

22       **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
24 without the Mayor's signature.
