4 **ORDINANCE 2020-503-E**

5 AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CALENDAR YEAR 2020 ANNUAL
6 TAXES ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN
7 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, INCLUDING ONLY URBAN
8 SERVICES DISTRICT FIVE, TO WIT: THE TOWN OF
9 BALDWIN; STATING THE PERCENTAGE CHANGE FROM
10 THE 2020 ROLLED-BACK RATE; AUTHORIZING
11 ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION; PROVIDING FOR THE
12 USE OF THE REVENUES GENERATED; PROVIDING AN
13 EFFECTIVE DATE.

15 **WHEREAS**, in 1982 the City of Jacksonville entered into an
16 Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Baldwin which established the
17 millage rate for the Town of Baldwin as a differential of not less
18 than 18.8% of the City of Jacksonville's General Services
19 District's millage rate; and

20 **WHEREAS**, this ordinance establishes the millage rate for the
21 Town of Baldwin in accordance with the Interlocal Agreement and
22 Chapter 200, Florida Statutes; now therefore

23 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

24 **Section 1. Ad valorem tax levy - General Services**
25 **District, including only Urban Service District 5 (The Town of**
26 **Baldwin).** In accordance with Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, and
27 the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the
28 Town of Baldwin, for the year 2020, there are hereby levied upon
29 all taxable real and personal property located within the General
30 Services District of the city, including only the Fifth Urban
31 Services District (the Town of Baldwin), for county purposes, ad

1 valorem taxes expressed in terms of mills on each dollar of
2 assessed taxable valuation in the amount of 9.6312 mills, or
3 \$9.6312 per \$1,000 assessed taxable value.

4 **Section 2. Percentage change from the rolled-back rate.**

5 The 2020 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated
6 City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services
7 District of the city, including only the Fifth Urban Services
8 District (Town of Baldwin), represents an 0.17% decrease from the
9 2020 rolled-back rate set forth in Resolution 2020-500-A; which is
10 the amount agreed upon in the Interlocal Agreement between the City
11 of Jacksonville and the Town of Baldwin.

12 **Section 3. Assessment and collection.** The Property

13 Appraiser of the county is authorized and directed to assess, and
14 the Tax Collector of the County is authorized and directed to
15 collect, pursuant to law, the ad valorem taxes levied in this
16 ordinance.

17 **Section 4. Use of revenues.** The revenues raised by the

18 ad valorem taxes levied in this ordinance shall be utilized in the
19 manner and for the purposes specified in the 2020-2021 budget and
20 appropriations ordinance.

21 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

22 effective upon signature by the Council President.
