(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The appropriation above is a Facility Recovery Grant from the United States Tennis Association (USTA) Florida Section Foundation to assist with costs associated with the closure of City tennis facilities because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in 8 Purpose. 9 Section 1 is to provide funding for materials and equipment to 10 assist in the recovery of costs associated with the resumption of operations at City tennis factilties. Due to the COVID-19 shutdown, 11 the City's tennis facilities experienced decreased revenues for 12 tennis programs and losses in court materials due to the clay 13 14 courts' sitting unused and unmaintained for several weeks. The 15 reimbursement grant funds have been approved to be used for supplies to assist with facility reopening, such as tennis balls, 16 teaching equipment, cleaning and sanitizing equipment, no-touch 17 items, and other expenses related to the reopening. Funds have been 18 approved in the following amounts for each of the four City of 19 20 Jacksonville Tennis Centers: Southside Tennis Center - \$5,000.00; 21 Boone Park Tennis Center - \$2,500.00; Fort Family Park Tennis Center - \$2,000.00; and, Clanzel T. Brown Tennis Center - \$2,250. 22 23 No local match is required. The funds must be spent by no later 24 than September 30, 2020.

25 Approval and authorization. Section 3. There is hereby 26 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 27 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 28 the City, the Facility Recovery Grant Award Letters for each of the 29 four City tennis facilities. Copies of the Facility Recovery Grant 30 Award Letters are attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. 31

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Section 4. Oversight. The Parks, Recreation and
 Community Services Department shall oversee the project described
 herein.
