28 WHEREAS, early identification of a child with sickle cell 29 disease coupled with antibiotic prophylaxis by 3 months of age and 30 early intervention services, helps those with sickle cell disease 31 while researchers continue to search for a cure; now therefore

The nature of the 11 emergency is that Sickle Cell Awareness Month is the month of 12 September and City Council desires to show its support for this 13 commemoration before the month is completed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
