Bill Summary: This bill appoints Sol Wynter to the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission (JHCDC), filling a seat formerly held by Tracy M. Grant as an advocate for low-income persons, for a first four-year term ending November 30, 2023.

Background Information: The JHCDC is established pursuant Section 34.203 a Commission to be known as the "Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission," which shall be comprised of 11 members, all of whom shall be residents of Duval County. Six members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council, and five members shall be appointed by the Council. Pursuant to the requirements of F.S. § 420.9076, (as amended from time to time) the Commission shall be deemed the "advisory committee" as required by state law.

Ms. Wynter is currently a Bilingual Sales Representative at Humana. She is currently pursuing a Bachelors of Science in Human Services from Florida State College of Jacksonville. She resides in Council District #2.
