EMW-2019-FF-01640 BETWEEN DHS/FEMA AND THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security / Federal Emergency Management Agency, with no local match.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund sixty (60) firefighter positions within the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department for the grant period beginning February 20, 2021 through February 19, 2024, which grant period may be amended consistent with Section 4 below. A copy of the DHS/FEMA grant Award Letter and Summary Award Memo is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Authorization of Positions. There are hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 21-007, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, DHS/FEMA Agreement No. EMW-2019-FF-01640 between DHS/FEMA and the City (the "Agreement"), substantially in the form placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services. If authorized and agreed to by DHS/FEMA and the Mayor or his designee, the Agreement may be amended to provide for an earlier commencement date, with such amendment being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the Mayor or his designee. The Agreement does not require a City match.

Section 5. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Fire

and Rescue Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee administration of the SAFER grant.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
