AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE ANNUAL REVIEW OF 9 FEES; AMENDING SECTION 106.112 (ANNUAL REVIEW 10 OF FEES), CHAPTER 106 (BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING 11 CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO REMOVE THE PROVISION 12 13 THAT ALLOWS FOR FEE INCREASES ΤO BECOME 14 EFFECTIVE UPON THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER 15 FILING CHANGES TO THE FEE STRUCTURE WITH THE 16 COUNCIL SECRETARY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE 17 DATE.

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19 Section 1. Amending Section 106.112 (Annual Review of 20 Fees), Ordinance Code. Section 106.112 (Annual review of fees), 21 Chapter 106 (Budget and Accounting Code), Ordinance Code, is hereby 22 amended to read as follows:

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CHAPTER 106. BUDGET AND ACCOUNTING CODE.

PART 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

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Sec. 106.112. Annual Review of fees.

27 The Chief Financial Officer of the City shall conduct a 28 review of the fees imposed by the various departments of the City 29 annually, and submit a report of his findings to the Council. 30 Upon the completion of each annual review of fees, The Chief

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Financial Officer shall, for each existing fee found to be less 1 than 85 percent of the actual cost to the City of providing the 2 service relating to such fee, increase the fee by the greater 3 amount of one-third of the difference between the existing fee and 4 5 actual cost to the City of providing the service or the amount of the increase from the previous year resulting from the preceding 6 7 calculation, but in no event shall the increase result in a fee greater than the actual cost to the City of providing the service 8 9 relating to such fee.

10 Upon completion of each annual review of fees, The Chief Financial Officer is authorized, for each existing fee found to be 11 equal to or more than 85 percent of the actual cost to the City of 12 providing the service relating to said fee, increase the fee 13 amount by up to the annual percentage change in the Consumer Price 14 Index. The Consumer Price Index shall mean the Consumer Price 15 Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U), U.S. City Average, all 16 items 1982-1984 = 100, or successor reports for the preceding 17 calendar year as initially reported by the United States 18 19 Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. Any fee changes 20 as noted herein will be accomplished through legislation.

21 The Chief Financial Officer shall file any change to the fee 22 structure with the Council Secretary and such increased fee shall 23 become effective upon such filing unless and until the Council 24 enacts an ordinance to the contrary.

25 Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
