Bill Summary: This bill amends Chapter 745 (Addressing and Street Naming Regulations), Part 1. (General Provisions), Ordinance Code. With the amendment, street name markers honoring fallen officers (who died in the line of duty) will depict the appropriate badge and/or emblem color from the law enforcement or fire/rescue agency.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to create a distinction among honorary street name markers for fallen officers (law enforcement and fire and rescue) as a tribute to their significant sacrifice and service to the overall public health and safety of Jacksonville citizens.

Policy Impact Area: Honorary Street Naming Regulations
