**Type of Action:** *Ordinance Code* amendment

**Bill Summary:** This bill amends Chapter 745 (Addressing and Street Naming Regulations), Part 1. (General Provisions), *Ordinance Code*. With the amendment, street name markers honoring fallen officers (who died in the line of duty) will depict the appropriate badge and/or emblem color from the law enforcement or fire/rescue agency.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to create a distinction among honorary street name markers for fallen officers (law enforcement and fire and rescue) as a tribute to their significant sacrifice and service to the overall public health and safety of Jacksonville citizens.

**Policy Impact Area:** Honorary Street Naming Regulations

**Fiscal Impact:** Undetermined costs for signage
