AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2020B SERIES TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE FUTURE LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, TO UPDATE MAP L-4, THE 100 YEAR FLOOD HAZARD AREA, FLOOD ZONE MAP, FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA'S VARIOUS AGENCIES FOR REVIEW; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE AMENDMENT TRANSMITTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has initiated 16 17 certain revisions and modifications to the text of the 2030 18 Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the procedures and requirements 19 set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, to amend the Future 20 Land Use Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, to update Map L-4, 21 the 100 Year Flood Hazard Area, Flood Zone Map, which is more 22 particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, dated October 2019, and attached 23 hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Jacksonville Planning Commission, as the Local Planning Agency, held a public hearing on this proposed Amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, with due public notice having been provided, and reviewed and considered all comments received during the public hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council; and

30 WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee held a public 31 hearing on this proposed Amendment pursuant to Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, and having considered all written and oral comments received during the public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and

4 WHEREAS, the City Council held a public hearing on this proposed 5 Amendment with public notice having been provided, pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance 6 7 Code, and having considered all written and oral comments received during the public hearing, the recommendations of the Planning and 8 9 Development Department, the Planning Commission and the LUZ 10 Committee, desires to transmit this proposed Amendment through the State's expedited state review process to the Florida Department of 11 12 Economic Opportunity, as the State Land Planning Agency, the Northeast 13 Florida Regional Council, the Florida Department of Transportation, 14 the St. Johns River Water Management District, the Florida Department 15 Environmental Protection, the Florida Fish and Wildlife of Conservation Commission, the Department of State's Bureau of Historic 16 17 Preservation, the Florida Department of Education, and the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Affairs; now, therefore 18

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the City of Jacksonville:

20 Section 1. Approval of Amendment for Transmittal Purposes. 21 The Council hereby approves the proposed 2020B Series Text Amendment 22 to the Future Land Use Element of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, as set 23 forth in Exhibit 1, dated October 2019, and attached hereto, for 24 transmittal to Florida's various required State Agencies for review.

25 Section 2. Disclaimer. The transmittal approved herein 26 shall **not** be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or 27 28 approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or 29 approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development or use, and transmittal is based upon acknowledgement, representation 30 31 and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s)

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1 and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the subject 2 business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance 3 with all laws. Transmittal does <u>not</u> approve, promote or condone any 4 practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, 5 state or local laws.

6 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 7 effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 8 without the Mayor's signature.
