AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$62,912.88 FROM THE VYSTAR VETERANS MEMORIAL ARENA TRUST FUND FOR DISBURSEMENT IN THE FORM OF MINI-GRANTS AWARDED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE **VETERANS** COUNCIL OF DUVAL COUNTY TO VARIOUS ORGANIZATIONS PROVIDING SERVICES TO VETERANS DUVAL COUNTY, RESIDING ΙN FLORIDA, INITIATED BY B.T. 21-011; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE MILITARY AFFAIRS AND VETERANS DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is an appropriation from the VyStar Veterans Memorial Arena Trust Fund in the cummulative

amount of \$62,912.88 for disbursement in the form of mini-grants awarded in conjunction with the Veterans Council of Duval County (the "Veterans Council") to various local organizations providing services to veterans residing in Duval County, Florida.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to certain eligible organizations serving veterans residing in Duval County, Florida, in the amounts listed on Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The City of Jacksonville operates in conjunction with the Veterans Council to disburse these funds as mini-grants to eligible organizations in accordance with the Veterans Memorial Arena Trust Fund Grant Guidelines, attached hereto as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by reference. This allocation supports the shared goals and objectives of the City and the Veterans Council to contribute to local organizations that serve the needs of veterans by working to improve their lives and morale.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Office of Military Affairs and Veterans shall oversee administration of the mini-grant contracts.

Section 4. Requesting one cycle emergency passage pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to expedite funding to allow eligible organizations receiving the aforementioned mini-grants the ability to provide more immediate relief and services to Duval County veterans.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
