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## RESOLUTION 2020-652-A

A RESOLUTION CONSIDERING A PETITION TO AMEND 4 5 THE VILLAGES OF WESTPORT COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT'S BOUNDARY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 6 7 190.046, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND CHAPTER 92, 8 ORDINANCE CODE, TO REMOVE APPROXIMATELY 9 1,058.56 ACRES FROM, AND ADD APPROXIMATELY 3.63 ACRES THE VILLAGES OF WESTPORT 10 TO, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT; REQUESTING 11 EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; DIRECTIVE 12 TO LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD 13 THE RECOMMENDATION, IF ANY, TO THE FLORIDA 14 AND WATER ADJUDICATORY COMMISSION; 15 LAND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 16

18 WHEREAS, the Villages of Westport Community Development 19 District ("District") was established pursuant to Florida Land and 20 Water Adjudicatory Commission ("FLWAC") Rule No. 42QQ-1, Florida 21 Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 92, Ordinance Code, and Sec. 22 23 190.046, F.S., the Board of Supervisors of the District, has by 24 District Board Resolutions 2020-06 and 2020-11, petitioned FLWAC to 25 amend the District's boundaries to add approximately 3.63 acres to 26 the District and contract the District's boundaries by approximately 27 1,058.56 acres, and has paid the required fee to defray the City's cost of review and consideration related to the Petition to Amend 28 29 the Boundary of the District (the "Petition"), a copy of which Petition together with its attendant attachments is **On File** with 30 Legislative Services; and 31

WHEREAS, as required by Sec. 92.14, Ordinance Code, the matter 1 2 was placed on the miscellaneous communications portion of the City Council Agenda on October 13, 2020 ("Communications from the Mayor 3 and Other Entities") for a voice vote as to whether the City 4 Council would like to hold a public hearing regarding its advisory 5 opinion to FLWAC regarding the Petition; and 6

7 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department provided its report and recommendation regarding the Petition to the full City 8 9 Council prior to the voice vote on October 13, 2020; and

10 WHEREAS, the Council determined that it did want to provide the public with a public hearing opportunity and requested that the 11 public hearing be held on October 27, 2020; and 12

13 WHEREAS, all notice requirements of Ch. 190, F.S., Sec. 92.11, Ordinance Code, and other applicable law were complied with, 14 15 complete notice was timely given, and a public hearing held on the date and time noticed and conducted thereafter in compliance with 16 17 F.S. Ch. 190, Sec. 92.11, Ordinance Code, and all applicable law; 18 and

WHEREAS, based upon the materials submitted by the District, 19 the Council finds there is good reason to recommend approval of the 20 21 Petition to FLWAC; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Boundary. In accordance with Sec. 23 Section 1. 190.046, 24 F.S., the City recommends approval of the Petition to Amend the Boundary of the Villages of Westport Community Development District 25 26 (the "Petition") to add approximately 3.63 acres, and contract the boundaries by approximately 1,058.56 acres to the Villages of 27 28 Westport Community Development (the "District") as set forth in the 29 legal description incorporated in the Petition **On File** with 30 Legislative Services Division.

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Section 2. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction

pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon 1 introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the 2 emergency is that Sec. 190.005, Florida Statutes, requires a public 3 hearing, if one is requested, to be held within 45 days of the 4 filing of the Petition. The Office of General Counsel received the 5 Petition and provided to the Council Secretary a Notice of Receipt 6 7 of the Petition on September 21, 2020 in accordance with Sec. 92.14, Ordinance Code. In order to be within the statutory 45 days 8 9 requirement, the public hearing before the full Council must be held 10 before November 5, 2020.

Section 3. Directive the Office Legislative 11 to of Services. Should the Council make a recommendation to FLWAC, the 12 Office of Legislative Services is directed to send a copy of the 13 Resolution to the Clerk of the Florida Land and Water Adjudicatory 14 Commission at e-mail address: FLWAC.Clerk@LASPBS.STATE.FL.US. 15

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming law without the Mayor's signature.
