21 WHEREAS, the Council adopted and approved the Consolidated 22 Downtown Development of Regional Impact (DRI) Development Order by 23 Resolution 92-392-489, and subsequently, has amended the Development 24 Order by various Resolutions and Ordinances, as was required by 25 Section 380.06, *Florida Statutes* (development orders); and

WHEREAS, Section 380.06, Florida Statutes, has been amended over time to remove DRI requirements and the Downtown Investment Authority, in collaboration with the Planning and Development Department, initiated the process and procedures to abandon the Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders, to simplify the regulatory procedures for development and redevelopment 1 in Downtown, enhance economic growth, and achieve the City of 2 Jacksonville's vision for Downtown; and

3 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has submitted 4 recommendations concerning the abandonment of the Consolidated 5 Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders; and

6 WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee has reviewed the 7 abandonment of the Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated 8 development orders, and made its recommendation to the Council; and

9 WHEREAS, a public hearing was properly noticed and held by the
10 Council pursuant to Section 380.06, *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, after such public hearing and in consideration of the recommendations made and submitted to the Council, the Council desires to abandon the Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 Section 1. Consolidated Downtown DRI Abandoned. The 17 Consolidated Downtown DRI, and its associated development orders, are 18 hereby abandoned pursuant to Section 380.06(11), Florida Statutes. 19 The Council finds that all conditions of Resolution 92-392-489, as 20 amended, which approved the development orders for the Consolidated 21 Downtown DRI have been met, are no longer applicable, or will continue 22 to be implemented through the City of Jacksonville Comprehensive Plan 23 and land development regulations, as described in Exhibit 1, attached Pursuant to Section 380.06(11), Florida Statutes, all 24 hereto. 25 development following abandonment shall be fully consistent with the 26 Comprehensive Plan and applicable zoning regulations in place at the 27 time of such future development.

28 Section 2. Notice. Pursuant to Section 380.06(11), 29 Florida Statutes, the Office of General Counsel is directed to prepare 30 and file a notice of the abandonment approved herein with the Clerk 31 of the Circuit Court for Duval County.
