The sources of the funds are projected fiscal year 2020-2021 revenues. 30 31 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in

Section 1 is to establish the fiscal year 2020-2021 operating budget for the Inmate Welfare Trust Fund in accordance with Section 111.300, Ordinance Code, and Section 951.23(9), Florida Statutes. The appropriation includes: \$79,533.97 in various salary subobjects for employees whose duties directly relate to the Trust Fund; \$347.00 in Workers' Compensation benefits for employees whose duties directly relate to the Trust Fund; \$3,201.00 in general liability insurance; \$239,461.03 for admission packs, indigent packs, law library supplies, recreational equipment, security cameras, and other related items; and, \$756,936.00 in "Specialized Equipment" for various capital equipment items at the Montgomery Correctional Facility, the Community Transition Facility, and the Pre-Trial Detention Facility. There are no requirements for a local match or additional staffing obligations.

Section 3. Authorization of Position. There is hereby authorized the position more fully described in R.C. 21-025, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
