ORDINANCE 2020-698

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN RUTGERS PLAZA II, LLC ("LANDLORD") AND THECITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("TENANT") TO LEASE APPROXIMATELY 6,000 SQUARE FEET OF SPACE AT THE RUTGERS PLAZA SHOPPING 1680 LOCATED AΤ DUNN CENTER, AVENUE, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32218 (RE #044213-0065), FOR USE BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE AS A SUBSTATION WITHIN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8, FOR A TERM OF TEN (10) YEARS AT A MONTHLY RENTAL RATE OF \$6,500.00 PER MONTH, WITH THREE PERCENT (3%) ANNUAL INCREASES AFTER THE INITIAL TERM ENDS; PROVIDING FOR INITIAL OVERSIGHT OF ACQUIRING THE LEASE BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND OVERSIGHT OF MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE LEASE BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, that certain Lease Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Rutgers Plaza II, LLC (the "Lease"), in substantially the same form as has been placed **On File** with the Office

of Legislative Services. The Lease provides for use of approximately 6,000 square feet of space at the Rutgers Plaza Shopping Center by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office as a substation, subject to the terms and conditions outlined therein. The Lease has an initial term of ten (10) years beginning September 1, 2020 at an initial rental rate of \$6,500.00 per month, with an escalation rate of three percent (3%) per year.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Real Estate Division, Public Works Department, shall provide initial oversight of acquiring the Lease and the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall thereafter provide oversight of management and administration of the Lease.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
