AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 307 (HISTORIC 6 7 PRESERVATION), ORDINANCE CODE; DESIGNATING THE 8 OLD BISBEE BUILDING, LOCATED AT 51 WEST BAY 9 STREET, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, AS A LOCAL 10 LANDMARK, PURSUANT TO APPLICATION LM-20-05; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO 11 NOTIFY THE APPLICANT, THE PROPERTY OWNER, AND THE 12 PROPERTY APPRAISER OF 13 THE LOCAL LANDMARK DESIGNATION, AND TO RECORD THE LOCAL LANDMARK 14 DESIGNATION IN THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF DUVAL 15 COUNTY; DIRECTING THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR TO 16 17 ENTER THE LOCAL LANDMARK DESIGNATION ON THE ZONING ATLAS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 18

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20 WHEREAS, the Council enacted Chapter 307 (Historic 21 Preservation), Ordinance Code, and determined therein that the 22 preservation, protection, enhancement, perpetuation and use of 23 landmarks, landmark sites and historic districts is a public necessity 24 because they have special historic, archaeological, aesthetic or 25 cultural interest and value; and; and

WHEREAS, the proposed local landmark is the Old Bisbee Building located at 51 West Bay Street, Real Estate Number 073663-0000, in Council District 7, constructed in 1901 just after the Great Fire of 1901; and

30 WHEREAS, the Old Bisbee Building is a reminder of the period of 31 reconstruction in the City Of Jacksonville; and 1 WHEREAS, the property owner is in favor of the landmark
2 designation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 307 (Historic 3 4 Preservation, Ordinance Code, the Council has considered the issue 5 of designating the Old Bisbee Building as a landmark, taking into consideration its importance and historical value, as more fully set 6 7 forth in the Designation Application, LM-20-05, and Staff Report of the Historic Preservation Section of the Planning and Development 8 9 Department, a copy of which is **on file** with Legislative Services as Exhibit 1, and incorporated by reference herein (the "Application and 10 Staff Report"); and 11

WHEREAS, all public notice and public hearing requirements have been met for designating the Old Bisbee Building as a local landmark; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2020, the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission reviewed and recommended approval of the proposed local landmark designation; and

WHEREAS, having met the requisite criteria, the Council finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Jacksonville to designate the Old Bisbee Building as a local landmark, in furtherance of historic preservation and protection; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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Section 1. Designation of Local Landmark. Pursuant to Chapter 307 (Historic Preservation), Ordinance Code, the Council hereby designates the Old Bisbee Building, located at 51 West Bay Street, in Council District 7, as a local landmark.

Section 2. Satisfaction of Requisite Criteria. The Council hereby finds that the Old Bisbee Building meets six (6) of the requisite criteria set forth in Section 307.104(j), Ordinance Code, as more fully set forth in the Application and Staff Report.

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1 Section 3. Notice and Recording. Pursuant to Section 2 307.104(m), Ordinance Code, the Council hereby directs the Chief of 3 Legislative Services, as designee of the Council Secretary, to notify 4 the applicant, the property owner, and the Property Appraiser of the 5 local landmark designation, and to record the local landmark 6 designation in the official records of Duval County, Florida.

Section 4. Landmark Designation on Zoning Atlas. Pursuant
to Section 307.104(n), Ordinance Code, the Council hereby directs the
Zoning Administrator, as designee of the Director of the Planning and
Development Department, to enter the local landmark designation on
the Zoning Atlas, in accordance with Section 656.203, Ordinance Code.

Section 5. Effective Date. The enactment of this ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and Council Secretary.
