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AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE PLANNING COMMISSION 5 RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE LAND USE AND ZONING 6 7 COMMITTEE AND THE COUNCIL; AMENDING CHAPTER 30 8 (PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT), PART 2 9 (PLANNING COMMISSION), SECTION 30.203 (CONDUCT 10 OF BUSINESS), ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING MINIMUM 11 NUMBER OF VOTES AT THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR 12 RECOMMENDATIONS; AMENDING CHAPTER 650 13 (COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING FOR FUTURE 14 DEVELOPMENT), PART 4 (AMENDMENTS TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN), SECTION 650.405 (PLANNING 15 COMMISSION ADVISORY RECOMMENDATION AND PUBLIC 16 17 HEARING), ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING THE TIMING 18 OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION; 19 AMENDING CHAPTER 656 (ZONING CODE), PART 1 20 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), SECTION 656.129 (ADVISORY 21 RECOMMENDATION ON AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING CODE 22 OR REZONING OF LAND), ORDINANCE CODE, REGARDING 23 TIMING OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION THE 24 RECOMMENDATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Amending Section 30.203 (Conduct of Business), Part 2 (Planning Commission), Chapter 30 (Planning and Development Department), Ordinance Code. Section 30.203 (Conduct of Business) is hereby amended to read as follows:

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Chapter 30 - PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT

PART 2. - PLANNING COMMISSION

Sec. 30.203. - Conduct of business.

5 The Commission shall meet at least twice each month as set forth herein (but it may waive one meeting each month by a majority vote 6 7 of the members), and special meetings shall be called in accordance with its rules. The Commission shall hold regular meetings on the 8 9 first and third Thursdays of each month commencing at such time and place as fixed by its bylaws, except for the first Thursday in July 10 11 and the third Thursday in December, so that such Commission meetings 12 are held on the Thursday that falls during the weeks that Council's 13 Standing Committees meet; and except that when a regular meeting day 14 shall fall on a legal holiday observed by the City, or on an election 15 day, the regular meeting of the Commission shall be held on a day and 16 at a time and place as fixed by its rules. Notwithstanding any 17 provision in these rules to the contrary, if a regular meeting day shall fall on a date that coincides with the observances of a 18 19 religious holiday, such regular meeting may be rescheduled at the 20 direction of the Commission Chairperson. A quorum shall consist of 21 five members or duly appointed alternates. The concurrence of a 22 majority of the Commission members (five) shall be required before 23 any report or recommendation is made on any matter considered by the 24 Commission, or to act upon and make a final determination regarding 25 a request for an exception, a variance, a waiver, approval of cellular 26 antenna reviews or minor modifications, or an appeal from the decision 27 of the Building Official; provided, however, after one deferral, a report or recommendation to the Council, or a committee thereof, 28 29 shall only require the concurrence of a majority of quorum (three). If, by reason of absence or disgualification of a member, a quorum 30 is not reached, the Chairperson of the Commission shall designate as 31

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many of the duly appointed alternates to serve as members on the 1 2 Commission for an individual meeting or until a vacancy is filled, 3 as may be needed to provide a quorum. When designated pursuant to the 4 provisions of this section, a duly appointed alternate shall be 5 entitled to participate in all proceedings and discussions of the 6 Commission to the same and full extent as provided by law for members, 7 including specifically the right to cast a vote as a voting member during the proceedings, except for votes concerning the election of 8 officers of the Commission, and shall have all the powers and duties 9 as otherwise provided by law. Any duly appointed alternate may 10 11 participate in any proceeding or discussion of the Commission but shall not be entitled to vote as a member of the Commission nor be 12 reimbursed pursuant to Part 7, Chapter 106 unless designated as a 13 voting alternate member by the Chairperson pursuant to this section. 14 15 A vacancy shall not impair the ability of the remaining members to 16 execute all the duties and perform all the functions of the 17 Commission. The Commission shall have the power to adopt, amend and repeal rules for its internal organization and the conduct of its 18 19 business.

20 Section 2. Amending Section 650.405 (Planning Commission 21 Advisory Recommendation and Public Hearing), Part 4 (Amendments to 22 the Comprehensive Plan), Chapter 650 (Comprehensive Planning for 23 Future Development), Ordinance Code. Section 650.405 (Planning 24 Commission Advisory Recommendation and Public Hearing) is hereby 25 amended to read as follows:

Chapter 650 - COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING FOR FUTURE DEVELOPMENT * * *

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Sec. 650.405. - Planning Commission advisory recommendation and public hearing.

PART 4. - AMENDMENTS TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

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Planning Commission advisory recommendation. 1 (a) The 2 Commission shall be responsible for making an advisory recommendation 3 to the Council with respect to each application to amend the 4 comprehensive plan. The recommendation shall be made to the Council 5 and shall become a part of the official legislative record of the application and the committee(s) of reference shall not report the 6 7 application to the Council until the recommendation has been received, except as provided in this subsection. Unless a longer time is 8 mutually agreed upon by the Council, the Commission and the Department 9 10 in the particular case, or the Commission does not submit a 11 recommendation to the appropriate committee of Council due to a delay 12 described in (b)(6) below, the Commission and the Department shall 13 submit their respective reports and recommendations to the Council 14 in not more than 63 days from the date an application to amend the comprehensive plan is introduced into City Council. If the Commission 15 16 or the Department fails to submit its report and recommendation to 17 the Council within the above prescribed time, such failure shall be 18 deemed to be a procedural recommendation for denial of the application 19 to amend the comprehensive plan and the Council may proceed to act 20 on the application to amend the comprehensive plan. In such case, the appropriate committee of Council shall serve as the Local Planning 21 22 Agency. The reports and recommendations of the Commission and the 23 Department shall be advisory only and shall not be construed to be 24 binding upon the Council.

(b) Planning Commission public hearing. The Planning Commission, acting as the Local Planning Agency, shall hold at least one public hearing, advertised pursuant to Section 650.407 below, on the proposed comprehensive plan amendment, pursuant to the following procedures:

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(6) If the applicant has not submitted the pictures of

the posted or reposted signs, if necessary, and the accompanying 1 notarized affidavit required per Section 650.407(c)(3), the 2 Department shall notify the Planning Commission, which shall delay 3 4 the hearing. The Planning Commission shall not approve or deny any 5 comprehensive plan amendment unless the applicant has submitted the pictures of the posted or reposted signs, if necessary, and the 6 7 accompanying notarized affidavit in accordance with the requirements set forth in Section 650.407(c)(3). If the Commission does not submit 8 a recommendation to the appropriate committee of Council due to a 9 delay caused by the applicant's failure to post and document the 10 11 posting of signs, the appropriate committee of Council shall delay the hearing on the application to amend the comprehensive plan until 12 13 the applicant has submitted the pictures of the posted or reposted 14 signs, if necessary, and the accompanying notarized affidavit and the 15 Planning Commission has submitted a recommendation.

16Section 3.AmendingSection656.129(Advisory17Recommendation on Amendment to Zoning Code or Rezoning of Land), Part181 (General Provisions), Chapter 656 (Zoning Code), Ordinance Code.19Section 656.129 (Advisory Recommendation on Amendment to Zoning Code)20or Rezoning of Land) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Chapter 656 - ZONING CODE

PART 1. - GENERAL PROVISIONS

* * *

Sec. 656.129. - Advisory recommendation on amendment to Zoning Code or rezoning of land.

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(c) Time for Recommendation.

(1) Unless a longer time is mutually agreed upon by the
Council, the Commission and the Department in the particular case,
or the Commission does not submit a recommendation to the appropriate
committee of Council due to a delay described in (b) above, the

1 Commission and the Department shall submit their respective reports 2 and recommendations to the Council in not more than 63 days from the 3 date a proposed amendment to the Zoning Code is introduced into City 4 Council.

5 (2) If the Commission or the Department fails to submit 6 its report and recommendation to the Council within the above 7 prescribed time, such failure shall be deemed to be a procedural recommendation for denial of the amendment to the Zoning Code or of 8 9 the proposal to rezone land and the Council may proceed to act on the amendment to the Zoning Code or proposal to rezone land. The reports 10 and recommendations of the Commission and the Department shall be 11 advisory only and shall not be construed to be binding upon the 12 Council. If the Commission does not submit a recommendation to the 13 appropriate committee of Council due to a delay caused by the 14 15 applicant's failure to post and document the posting of signs, the 16 appropriate committee of Council shall delay the hearing on the zoning 17 application until the applicant has submitted the pictures of the posted or reposted signs, if necessary, and the accompanying notarized 18 affidavit and the Planning Commission has submitted a recommendation. 19 20

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
