17 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
18 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated and

3 outside counsel.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of this appropriation is

6 attorney's fees for legal representation for City employees and
7 officials who have retained outside counsel.

8 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall
9 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
10 effective without the Mayor's signature.
