There is hereby 22 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation 23 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, DHS/FEMA 24 Agreement No. EMW-2019-FF-01640 between DHS/FEMA and the City (the 25 "Agreement"), substantially in the form placed **On File** with the 26 Office of Legislative Services. If authorized and agreed to by 27 DHS/FEMA and the Mayor or his designee, the Agreement may be 2.8 amended to provide for an earlier commencement date, with such 29 amendment being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the 30 Mayor or his designee The Agreement does not require a City match.
