The Office of Grants and Contract Compliance will provide oversight and administrative assistance to the Fire Watch Council as provided in the Interlocal Agreement.

Background Information: The Fire Watch Council is a coordinated effort between the City of Jacksonville and Baker, Clay, Nassau, and St. Johns Counties to end veteran suicide in the region. It coordinates and organizes existing resources to combat the veteran suicide epidemic in partnership with local, state, and federal agencies, private donors, media outlets, and nonprofits.

Policy Impact Area: Public health and safety, Northeast Florida Fire Watch Council

Fiscal Impact: The funding is being transferred from funds authorized for the Florida Georgia Game Contingency account as these funds were reserved but not utilized for expenses related to the Florida Georgia game taking place on November 7, 2020.
