4 **ORDINANCE 2020-758**

5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$140,000 FROM THE  
6 SOCIAL JUSTICE AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT SPECIAL  
7 COMMITTEE CONTINGENCY TO KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE  
8 ("KHA") TO ALLOW KHA TO PROVIDE FUNDING TO THE  
9 TEEN COURT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING KHA TO PROVIDE  
10 FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$140,000 TO TEEN COURT  
11 TO PROVIDE FOR 2.5 CASE MANAGERS AND ADDITIONAL  
12 COUNSELING; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS  
13 DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY, AND/OR THE  
14 CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE KIDS HOPE  
15 ALLIANCE TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A SERVICES  
16 CONTRACT WITH TEEN COURT TO PROVIDE THE SERVICES  
17 SPECIFIED IN THIS ORDINANCE; INVOKING THE  
18 EXCEPTION OF SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS),  
19 PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126  
20 (PROCUREMENT CODE), *ORDINANCE CODE*, REGARDING  
21 THE SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY TEEN COURT;  
22 WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 77 (KIDS  
23 HOPE ALLIANCE), SECTION 77.111(A) (PROVIDER  
24 CONTRACTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO EXEMPT THE  
25 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY TEEN COURT FROM  
26 COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT; PROVIDING FOR  
27 OVERSIGHT BY THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE; PROVIDING  
28 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

30 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

31 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,

1 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
2 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
3 listed in subsection (b):

10 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

11 The appropriation above provides \$140,000 in funding from  
12 the Social Justice and Community Investment Special  
13 Committee Contingency account to KHA to provide funding to  
14 Teen Court for 2.5 additional case managers and to provide  
15 additional counseling.

16 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
17 Section 1 is to provide funding in the amount of \$140,000 to allow  
18 KHA to provide funding to Teen Court for 2.5 additional case managers  
19 and to provide additional counseling. A description of the Teen Court  
20 services and proposed budget is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

21 **Section 3. Approval and authorization to execute.** The  
22 Mayor, or his designee, the Corporation Secretary, and/or the Chief  
23 Executive Officer ("CEO") of KHA are hereby authorized to execute and  
24 deliver a contract with Teen Court for the services specified in this  
25 ordinance, in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 3** and  
26 incorporated herein.

27 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**  
28 **Ordinance Code.** KHA is hereby authorized to directly procure the  
29 use of the professional services of Teen Court, to provide services  
30 as more particularly described in Section 2. Pursuant to Section  
31 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126

1 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is exempted from  
2 competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be  
3 provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing  
4 legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the  
5 foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall  
6 remain in full force and effect.

7 **Section 5. Waiving the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids**  
8 **Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), Ordinance**  
9 **Code.** The City hereby waives the requirements of Chapter 77 (Kids  
10 Hope Alliance), Section 77.111(a) (Provider Contracts), *Ordinance*  
11 *Code*, with respect to the contract approved and authorized under  
12 Section 3 of this Ordinance. Section 77.111(a) requires contracts for  
13 children's services to be competitively procured by KHA via an  
14 evaluated bid process. This waiver is needed to allow KHA to meet  
15 grant requirements.

16 **Section 6. Oversight.** KHA will oversee the project and  
17 services described in Section 2 above and will ensure compliance with  
18 all other appropriate laws.

19 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become  
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
21 without the Mayor's signature.
